CONDITIONAL

Present tense formation:

já	bych	
ty	bys	
on	by	
my	bychom (coll: bysme)	} + past tense of verb
vy	byste	
oni	by	

(all forms can be prefixed by *kdy-* or *a-*)

Past tense adds the past tense of *být* (1-participle). Note that if the main verb is *být*, *bývat* will be used in its place.

Usage: 1) Contrary-to-fact statements ("If I had a million dollars ...")
2) Politeness (cf. use of "would like" & "could" instead of "want" & "can")
